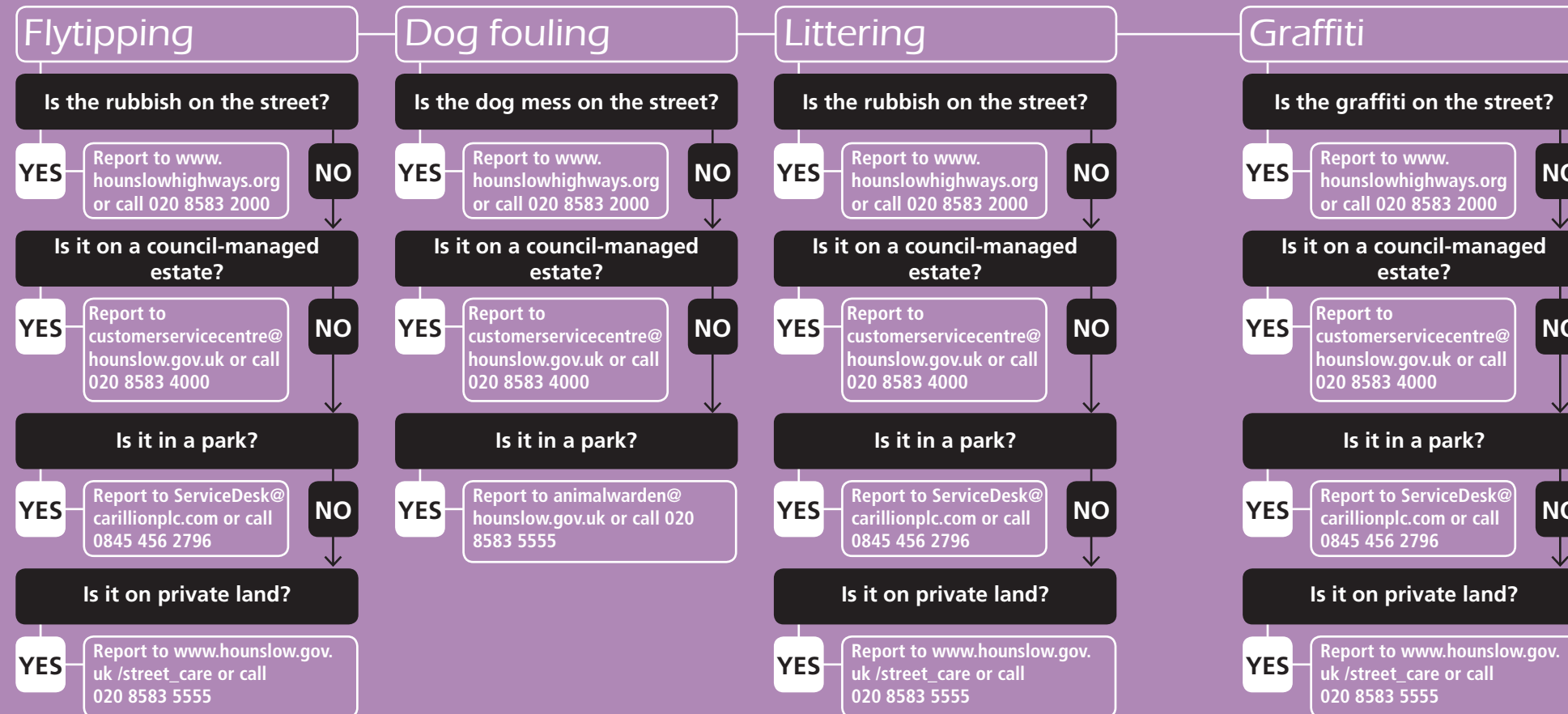


Who to contact - and when?

The council's enforcement team are working tirelessly to keep the borough clean and safe. A lot of the work they do comes from reports by residents but knowing who deals with what can be confusing. Our handy chart will help you understand who to contact when you have a problem.



Noise nuisance

Report noise nuisances to the council's enforcement team. Visit www.hounslow.gov.uk/noisenuisance and complete the online form or call 020 8583 5555.

The council also has a weekend, night-time noise team who work on Fridays from 10pm to 4am and Saturdays from 10pm to 4am. If you have a problem during these hours call 020 8583 2222.
